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# CALL FOR PROPOSALS “INCOMING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM 2025/2 (INTEGRATION GRANT)”

## I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

### 1. The Call for Proposals

- 1.1. The Call for Proposals “Incoming Research Fellowship Program 2025/2 (Integration Grant)”, (hereinafter ‘**Call for Proposals**’) is carried out in accordance with the Order № 1368-Ս/2 dated June 12, 2025, issued by the Minister of Education, Science, Culture, and Sports of the Republic of Armenia (hereinafter ‘**Minister**’).
- 1.2. The **Call for Proposals** is organized by the Higher Education and Science Committee of the Ministry of Science, Education, Culture, and Sports of the Republic of Armenia (hereinafter ‘**Committee**’), being guided by the Procedure for Research Grant Funding of Scientific and Technical Activity established by the RA Government Decision №156-N dated February 13, 2025.
- 1.3. The **Call for Proposals** aims to establish new scientific subdivisions in prospective and cutting-edge research areas under the supervision of foreign scientists under the umbrella of the organizations carrying out a program within the framework of basic funding for scientific and technical activities from the state budget of the Republic of Armenia (hereinafter ‘**Organization**’).
- 1.4. The **Call for Proposals** covers all research fields of scientific and technical activities (listed in Annex №2.1).
- 1.5. The procedure of the **present Call** implies submitting an application (hereinafter ‘**Application**’), which shall include the description of the scientific project (hereinafter ‘**Project**’) and other supporting documents/data.
- 1.6. The submitted **Project** (Annex №2.2) shall be ambitious, competitive, promising, and feasible.
- 1.7. A publication in a periodical indexed in International Scientific databases (hereinafter an ‘**ISD-indexed publication**’) is hereby defined as an article, review, letter, conference paper, proceedings paper, book chapter included in the Web of Science Core Collection or Scopus Scientific Database.

A monograph (hereinafter referred to as '**Monograph**') is defined as a Book of at least 5 author's sheets included in the Web of Science Core Collection or Scopus Scientific Database.

- 1.8. For the specialties included in Research Field **#6 of Annex 2.1**, **1 Monograph** is tantamount to **4 ISD-indexed publications**.
- 1.9. The terms of the **Call for Proposals** shall define the application procedure, the stages, and criteria of **Application** evaluation, as well as funding and reporting procedures for the beneficiary **Application**.

## 2. Purpose

### 2.1. The purposes of the present Call for Proposals are as follows:

- Foster domestic and international collaboration;
- Increase the scientific and technical capacity of the respective hosting Organization;
- Involve researchers from the Diaspora and overseas;
- Engage young researchers and PhD students;
- Promote the integration of young scientists into the international research area;
- Improve the scientific environment;
- Create new, competitive, and prospective scientific subdivisions;
- Strengthen the impact of research on socioeconomic development;
- Improve competitiveness in science.

## 3. Timeframes

- 3.1. The **Projects** approved for funding shall be carried out within 60 months.
- 3.2. The submission deadline for the **Call for Proposals** via the Online **Application** System ([irf-armenia-2025.hesc.am](http://irf-armenia-2025.hesc.am)) is **July 31, 2025, 18:00**, Yerevan time (GMT+4).
- 3.3. The deadline for the submission of the paper-based documents by the **Organization's** representative to the **Committee** is **August 7, 2025**.
- 3.4. The funding of the selected **Projects** under the **Call** is expected to start in November 2025.
- 3.5. **Contracts** on **Project** funding shall be signed within 10 days after the arrival of the beneficiary Principal Investigators to the Republic of Armenia upon the announcement of the results of the **Call**.
- 3.6. Implementation **Reports** shall be submitted by the last working day of every 12<sup>th</sup> month since the commencement of the **Project**.
- 3.7. The **Project** shall be implemented within the timeframes specified in the **Contract**.

## 4. Group

- 4.1. The **Project** is developed and implemented by a group of 3-5 researchers (hereinafter '**Group**') consisting of a principal investigator from abroad (hereinafter '**PI**') and members of the group (hereinafter together referred to as **Group Members**).
- 4.2. The members of the **Group** can hold any citizenship at the moment of the submission of the Application.
- 4.3. The **Group Members** should be either citizens or residents of the Republic of Armenia and reside in Armenia during the whole implementation of the **Project**.
- 4.4. The **Group** shall have a Foreign Partner or Collaborator (hereinafter '**Collaborator**').
- 4.5. The **Group** shall be represented only by the **PI**.

## 5. The PI

- 5.1. The **Application** shall be submitted by the **PI of the Group**.
- 5.2. The **PI** of the **Group** shall:
  - be born after January 1, 1975;
  - have received a scientific degree after January 1, 2005;
  - neither have studied nor worked in the Republic of Armenia for a cumulative period of 12 months during the last 4 years by the deadline of the **Call** (July 31, 2025), except for the PIs of the projects implemented under the PostDoc-Armenia 2023 Program.
- 5.3. The **PI** of the **Group** shall have publications published during the last 5 years (2020-2025) which meet the following criteria:

*For research fields #1-5 (NS, ET, MS, AS, and SS) listed in **Annex 2.1**:*

- **4 ISD-indexed** publications;
- or have an h-index (Hirsch) of at least 10, according to the Scopus Scientific Database (<https://www.scopus.com/freelookup/form/author.uri>).

*For research field #6 (AH) listed in **Annex 2.1**:*

- **2 ISD-indexed** publications;
- or 1 **Monograph**.

- 5.4. If any of the submitted publications are included in Beall's list (<https://beallslist.net/>) of predatory and fraud publications or journals, the issue of the admissibility of the **Application** for expertise shall further be considered at the **Applications** evaluation stage.
- 5.5. The **PI** is responsible for the formation of the **Group** and the successful implementation of the **Project**.

## 6. Group Members

- 6.1. At least 2 **Group Members** shall be born after January 1, 1990. Undergraduate students who are in their third year or above are eligible.  
The age threshold of the **Group Members** can be extended in the following cases:

- in the case of military service - for 2 years;
  - in the case of parental leave - for 1 year for each child.
- 6.2. **Group Members** can be first-year undergraduate students majoring in the fields related to the scientific and technical field of the **Project** specified in Annex 2.1 and awarded at least a 3<sup>rd</sup>-level diploma at the republican-level School Subject Olympiad in their 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> school grade.
- 6.3. At least one of the young **Group Members** (born after Jan 1, 1990) shall not be involved in any program funded within the basic funding of scientific and technical activities from the state budget of Armenia.
- 6.4. **Group Members** shall not be involved in more than one **Application** within the present **Call for Proposals**.
- 6.5. **Group Members** shall not be among the recipients of the following grants:
- “Support Program for Advanced Research”;
  - “Consolidator Grant for Research Laboratories (Subdivisions)”;
  - “Incoming Research Fellowship Program (Integration Grant)”;
  - “Adjunct Research Professorship Program (Remote Laboratory)”.

## 7. Foreign Partner (Collaborator)

- 7.1. The **Group** shall have a Foreign partner (**Collaborator**).
- 7.2. The **Collaborator of the Group** shall:
- hold a scientific degree;
  - carry out research activities in any foreign research institution in the **Project-related** field.
- 7.3. The **Collaborator of the Group** shall have an h-index (Hirsch) of at least 15, according to the Scopus Scientific Database (<https://www.scopus.com/freelookup/form/author.uri>), for research fields #1-4 listed in Annex 2.1, and at least a 3 h-index for research fields #5-6 listed in Annex 2.1, or at least **8 ISD-indexed** publications in the particular research field published during the last 5 years.
- 7.4. The **Collaborator** shall not be regarded as a member of the **Group**, and no remuneration shall be envisaged for their activities.
- 7.5. The **Collaborator** shall provide the **PI** of the **Group** with their academic CV and a Confirmation Letter restating their awareness of the **Project** content, the scope of their responsibilities, envisaged joint events (scientific experiments, meetings, and seminars), as well as their consent to their involvement in research activities.
- 7.6. At least one of the publications published as an output of the **Project** shall list the **Collaborator** as a co-author.
- 7.7. During the whole period (60 months) of the **Project** implementation, the **Collaborator** must spend a cumulative period of no less than 25 days at the hosting **Organization** in the

Republic of Armenia, as well as host **Group Members** in their respective foreign scientific institution for a cumulative period of no less than 25 days.

- 7.8. The **Collaborator** shall not be involved in more than one **Application** under the present **Call**.

## 8. Organization Eligibility

- 8.1. The **Organization** shall be among those implementing the program funded within the basic funding of scientific and technical activities from the state budget of the Republic of Armenia.
- 8.2. The **Organization** shall provide the **Group Members** with access to its infrastructure and equipment throughout the implementation of the **Project**.
- 8.3. The **Organization** shall support the implementation of the **Project**.
- 8.4. The **Organization** must provide the **PI** with the scientific board conclusion of the **Organization** (or, in the case of higher education institutions, that of a particular department) regarding the **Project's** relevance, importance, and correspondence to the **Organization's** scope of activities.
- 8.5. The **Organization** shall include the **PI of the Group** in a program of basic funding of scientific and technical activities at least throughout the completion of the **Project**.
- 8.6. By the 24<sup>th</sup> month of the implementation of the **Project**, a new scientific subdivision (group, laboratory, department) shall be established under the umbrella of the **Organization** within the basic funding of scientific and technical activities, ensuring the involvement of the **PI** (Head of the Subdivision) and **Group Members** (Employees of the Subdivision). The total workload of the employees involved in the **Project** shall comprise no less than 120 hours per week (3 Full-time Equivalent, FTE).
- 8.7. The Head of the **Organization** provides the **PI** with a reference letter confirming their awareness of the conditions of the **Call** and expressing their readiness to allocate the financial resources from the basic funding of the **Organization** to comply with the provisions specified in Subparagraphs 8.5 and 8.6 of the present **Call**.
- 8.8. The **Organization** creates necessary conditions for the implementation of the **Project** at the expense of financial resources envisaged in the "Overhead Costs" subsection of the "Other Expenses" section of the Financial Estimate (hereinafter '**Estimate**').
- 8.9. The equipment, materials, and services necessary for the implementation of the **Project** shall be purchased in the manner prescribed by the RA Law "On Procurements" in conformity with the regulations of public-needs-oriented procurements.
- 8.10. The equipment and devices purchased shall be included in the balance sheet of the **Organization**, and the right of disposal thereof shall belong to the **Organization**, including subsequent use thereof for statutory purposes, i.e., for carrying out research activities.
- 8.11. After the approval of the Project for funding, a **Contract** shall be signed between the **Organization**, the **Committee**, and the **PI** of the **Project** for the use of the amounts of

financial assistance provided by the state in the form of a grant for the implementation of contractual projects of scientific and technical activities (hereinafter '**Contract**').

## 9. Expected Results

9.1. In all publications produced as an output of the **Project**, it is necessary to indicate the funding received from the **Committee** as follows:

*The research was supported by the Higher Education and Science Committee of MESCS RA (Research Project № \_\_\_\_\_)*

9.2. By the 35<sup>th</sup> month since the commencement of the **Project**, the **Group Members** shall present the following publications with an indication of the **Organization** as the author's affiliation and containing the note stipulated in Subparagraph 9.1. of the **Call**.

- For research fields #1-5 (listed in Annex 2.1):
  - At least 4 **ISD-indexed** publications;
- For research field #6 (listed in Annex 2.1):
  - At least 2 **ISD-indexed** publications;
  - Or 1 **Monograph**.

**Attention: Without the aforementioned notes, the publication shall not be considered as a Project Output and, therefore, shall not be included in the report.**

9.3. In the case of failure to comply with the provisions of Subparagraph 9.2. of the **Call** by the 35<sup>th</sup> month since the commencement of the **Project**, it may be decided to terminate the funding of the **Project** upon the conclusion of the **Board**.

9.4. After the completion of the **Project** (for an overall period of 60 months), the **Group Members** shall present the following publications with an indication of the **Organization** as the author's affiliation and containing the funding acknowledgment statement as outlined in Subparagraph 9.1. of the **Call**.

- For research fields #1-5 (listed in Annex 2.1):
  - A minimum of 10 **ISD-indexed** publications, at least 2 of which shall be in Q1 journals and another 2 - in Q2 journals.
- For research field #6 (listed in Annex 2.1):
  - A minimum of 5 **ISD-indexed** publications, at least 2 of which shall be in Q1 journals and another 2 - in Q2 journals.
  - Or 2 **Monographs**.

9.5. In at least 5 publications produced as an output of the **Project** for research fields #1-5 listed in Annex 2.1, and at least 3 publications for research field #6 listed in Annex 2.1, the **PI** shall be either the first, the last, or the corresponding author, or credited in any equivalent capacity. At least one of the publications published as an output of the **Project** shall involve the **Collaborator** as a co-author.



- 9.6. As an output of the **Project**, the **Group** is expected to apply for an international grant (at least one submitted grant) and submit a relevant certifying letter. The grant budget for research fields #1-5 should amount to at least AMD 25,000,000; for research field #6 - at least 15,000,000 AMD.
- 9.7. Within the frames of the **Project's** implementation, the **Group** is expected to ensure the creation and dissemination of popular science materials about the **Project** or their particular field of science (interviews, publications in popular science journals, creation, and distribution of video materials, organization of discussions for general audience, etc.). These dissemination efforts shall be considered when evaluating and accepting the **Project's** final report.
- 9.8. Both successful compliance and noncompliance with the provisions of Subparagraphs **9.2.**, **9.4.**, **9.5.** and **9.6.** shall respectively affect the evaluation score of the future applications submitted by the **Group Members** to the upcoming **Call for Proposals** announced by the **Committee**. Particularly, the amount of 5 percent of the final evaluation score shall be subtracted from (in the case of noncompliance) or added to (in the case of compliance) the evaluation score of the applications submitted in the future with the involvement of **PI** (irrespective of their future capacity), and the amount of 1 percent of the final evaluation score - for the future applications with the involvement of each **Group Member**. The score shall be affected by a maximum amount of 5 percent of the total score. The reduction of the final expertise score of future applications submitted by the **Group Members** for subsequent **Calls for Proposals** shall cease to apply once the **Committee** is duly notified about the compliance with the provisions of Subparagraphs **9.2.**, **9.4.**, **9.5.** and **9.6.**

## II. PROCEDURE FOR COMPLETION AND SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

### 10. Submission of the Application and Supporting Documents

- 10.1. The **Application** shall be filled in and submitted by the **PI** via the Online **Application** System <https://irf-armenia-2025.hesc.am/>. The Application deadline for the Call for Proposals is **July 31, 2025, 18:00**, Yerevan time (GMT+4).
- 10.2. After the submission of the Application via the system, the PI shall submit the following paper-based documents to the **Organization**:
- **PI's** application letter (Annex 2.3);
  - **Estimate**;
  - the scientific board's conclusion;
  - a confirmation letter by the Head of the host **Organization** under Subparagraphs **8.5.** and **8.6.** of the present **Call**;

- for those **Group Members** who are undergraduate, graduate, and postgraduate students, references from their universities are required with an indication of specialty and the year of study;
- the copies of diplomas envisaged under Subparagraph **6.5.** of the present **Call**;
- the academic CVs of the **Group Members**,
- copy of military service book or relevant documents for maternity leave to increase the age limits,
- the **Collaborator's** academic CV and the Letter of Confirmation.

10.3. Other documents may be required if necessary.

10.4. By August 7, 2025, a representative of the **Organization** (Scientific Secretary or another authorized person) shall submit the hard copies of all Applications' supporting documents from their respective **Organization** to the **Committee** (address: 22 Orbeli Brothers St., 9<sup>th</sup> floor, 907 room, during working hours) in one package, accompanied with a letter by the Head of the **Organization** as specified in Annex 2.4.

**Attention: The Committee shall consider only those applications that are submitted via the System. The applications that have not been submitted in compliance with the aforementioned procedure or deadlines shall not be considered.**

## 11. Estimate

11.1. The **Estimate** consists of two sections: "Remuneration" and "Other Costs". The "Other Costs" section includes "Equipment, Materials and Services", "Travels", "Consolidation of Group/Laboratory", and "Overhead Costs" subsections.

11.2. The maximum amount of funding for the whole duration of the **Project** is as follows: AMD 148,000,000 (one hundred and forty-eight million), AMD 125,000,000 (one hundred and twenty-five million), and AMD 102,000,000 (one hundred and two million) for 5-, 4-, and 3-member **Groups**, respectively. In the case of the PI's relocation to the Republic of Armenia with family member(s) – the maximum amount of funding shall be AMD 157,000,000 (one hundred and fifty-seven million), AMD 134,000,000 (one hundred and thirty-four million), and AMD 111,000,000 (one hundred and eleven million) for 5-, 4-, and 3-member **Groups**, respectively.

11.3. For the "Remuneration" section of the **Estimate** the following monthly gross amounts shall be considered:

- The maximum monthly salary for the **PI** shall be AMD 600,000 (six hundred thousand) gross, and in the case of their relocation to the Republic of Armenia with family member(s) - AMD 750,000 (seven hundred fifty thousand) gross;

- The average monthly salary of the **Group Members** shall be under AMD 300,000 (three hundred thousand) gross, and the minimum monthly salary - AMD 150,000 (one hundred and fifty thousand) gross.

- 11.4. If the total remuneration is less than the amount mentioned above in Subparagraph 11.3., the surplus can be used in the “Other Costs” section of the **Estimate**.
- 11.5. No remuneration is envisaged for the **Collaborator** of the **Group**, and they are not considered as a Group member.
- 11.6. For the “Equipment, Materials, and Services”, “Travels”, and “Overhead Costs” subsections of the “Other Costs” section of the **Estimate**, an amount of AMD 25,000,000 (twenty-five million), AMD 20,000,000 (twenty million), AMD 15,000,000 (fifteen million), and AMD 10,000,000 (ten million) for a total of 60 months shall be considered for 5-, 4-, 3- and 2-member **Groups**, respectively.  
The amount of funding envisaged for those costs can be increased at the expense of the surplus mentioned in Subparagraph 11.4.
- 11.7. The expenses for purchasing scientific equipment, materials, and services necessary for the research may be envisaged under the “Equipment, Materials, and Services” subsection of the “Other Costs” section of the **Estimate**. A contract for services may be signed only with legal entities upon the consent of the **Committee**.
- 11.8. The purchase of scientific equipment shall not be envisaged for the last year of the **Project** implementation.
- 11.9. The costs for the implementation process and presentation of the proceedings of the **Project** at international conferences and mutual visits of the **Collaborator** and the **Group Members** may be envisaged under the “Travel” subsection of the “Other Costs” section of the **Estimate**.
- 11.10. When calculating daily and accommodation costs of the study visits, it is necessary to be guided by the Decree of the Government of the Republic of Armenia №2335-Ն dated December 29, 2005.
- 11.11. An amount of AMD 15,000,000 (fifteen million) may be allocated to the improvement of the laboratory/group infrastructure and other **Project-related** costs for the first 12 months under the “Consolidation of Group/Laboratory” subsection of the “Other Costs” section of the **Estimate**.
- 11.12. Up to AMD 2,500,000 (two million five hundred thousand) may be requested within a period of 60 months under the “Overhead Costs” subsection of the “Other Costs” section of the **Estimate**.
- 11.13. All subsections of the **Estimate** shall be justified in the **Budget Estimate Narrative**.
- 11.14. During the evaluation of the Project, the justification and distribution of the **Estimate** may be amended upon the consent of the **PI**.

### III. APPLICATION CONSIDERATION AND EVALUATION

#### 12. Conformity of Applications to the Terms of the Call

12.1. The **Committee** shall consider the following circumstances:

- Compliance of the submitted **Applications** with the terms of the **Call**;
- Whether the **Application** contains publications included in Beall's list (<https://beallslit.net/>) of fake and predatory publishers or journals.

12.2. The **Application** shall not be considered if:

- it does not contain all the required documentation;
- it does not meet the **Call's** criteria;
- its content is identical to one of the research projects funded, currently or previously, from the state budget of the Republic of Armenia.

12.3. The results of the examination shall be provided to the Board, which is established for guaranteeing funding of the applications and receiving reports on their implementation (hereinafter **Board**).

12.4. The **Board** shall consider and approve the list of **Applications** subject to **Expertise**.

12.5. The **PIs** of the **Groups** whose Applications do not meet the criteria specified in the **Call** shall be duly notified electronically about not being shortlisted for the Expertise stage.

#### 13. Expertise

13.1. **The Board**, in cooperation with **the Committee**, shall elaborate and approve the evaluation sheets and the procedure for the first and second stages of Expertise of Applications.

13.2. During the 1<sup>st</sup> Stage of Expertise, the **Board** shall consider the Extensive Summary (Annex 2.5) of the **Project**.

13.3. At the 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage of Expertise, the Experts shall evaluate the **Application (Project)** and the **Board** shall conduct an interview with the **PI**.

13.4. Pursuant to the provisions of the RA Law "On Scientific and Technical Expertise", the **Committee**, the **Board**, or the experts shall be prohibited from providing any information regarding the **Applications'** content, the Expertise process, and the results thereof to a third party.

#### 14. The 1<sup>st</sup> Stage of Expertise (Extensive Summary Evaluation)

14.1. During the 1<sup>st</sup> Stage of Expertise, the **Board** shall consider the Extensive Summary of the **Project**, the **PI's** track record, their academic **CVs**, and the **Organization's** and **Collaborator's** compatibility with the **Project's** purposes. Subsequently, based on the **Board** members' consensus, the shortlist of eligible applications for the next stage of Expertise shall be formed.

14.2. The **Applicants** that have not been shortlisted for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage of Expertise shall be duly notified electronically.

## 15. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage of Expertise (Expert Evaluation)

15.1. At the 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage of Expertise, the Experts shall evaluate the **Application**, and the **Board** shall conduct an interview with the **PIs**.

The Experts shall evaluate the following aspects of the Application:

- the scientific and technical novelty and relevance of research,
- the validity of the prerequisites, stages, and timespan of the **Project**,
- prospects and impact on the development of the particular research area,
- previous achievements of the **Group Members** in the particular research area, as well as compliance of their professional qualifications in terms of the **Project** objectives,
- the compliance of the **Collaborator's** professional qualifications in terms of the **Project** objectives, and the feasibility of cooperation,
- management and dissemination of scientific results,
- justification of financial means requested, as well as
- other issues related to the peculiarities of the current **Call**.

15.2. At least 2 independent experts shall review the Application. A **Board Member** is also entitled to act as an independent expert.

15.3. For each **Application**, the expert shall fill out the Expert Evaluation Sheet.

15.4. The maximum score of the Interview shall not exceed 50% of the maximum evaluation score of the **Application**.

15.5. If the scores of two experts differ by 30 percent or more from the maximum evaluation score of expertise, the **Application** shall be subject to further examination by a third expert.

## 16. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage of Expertise (Interview)

16.1. The **Board** shall conduct interviews with the **PIs of the Groups**.

16.2. Each member of the **Board** shall fill out an Interview Evaluation Sheet for each **Application**.

16.3. The maximum score for the Interview amounts to 50% of the maximum evaluation score for the **Application**.

## 17. Evaluations Results

17.1. The total score of expertise shall be calculated as the sum of the arithmetic mean of the Evaluation Scores of 2 experts and the Interview Score. If the **Application** has been evaluated by 3 experts, the final **Application** score shall be calculated as the sum of the arithmetic mean of two of the closest scores submitted by 3 experts (in the case of equal difference between 3 experts' scores – the arithmetic mean of two higher scores) and the arithmetic mean of the Interview scores.

17.2. Based on the final evaluation results of the **Applications** shortlisted for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage of Expertise, the **Committee** shall form the Application Ranking List by research areas in descending order and further submit it to the **Board**.

- 17.3. The **Board** approves the **Application** Ranking List and presents to the **Committee** the recommended threshold score for each research field.
- 17.4. Based on the volume of allocations from the Republic of Armenia's state budget for the research grant funding of scientific and technical activities, the **Committee** shall determine the threshold score for each of the research fields and shall submit the list of the **Applications** eligible for funding and the amount of funding for each Project to the **Minister's** approval.
- 17.5. The list of **Applications** eligible for funding and the amount of funding thereof shall be approved by the Order of the **Minister**.
- 17.6. The list of **Applications** eligible for funding as a result of the **Call** shall be published on the official website of the **Committee**.
- 17.7. The **Committee** shall duly provide each Head of the **Organization** with the Approved **Applications** List for their respective **Organization**.
- 17.8. The **Committee** shall provide the **PIs** with the Expertise results and the threshold score.

#### IV. OTHER PROVISIONS

##### 18. Contract Signing

- 18.1. The **Committee**, the **Organization**, and the **PI** of the approved **Application** shall sign a **Contract**.
- 18.2. To ensure the monthly remuneration of the **PI** and **Members** of the **Group**, the **Organization** shall sign contracts in the manner prescribed by the RA "Civil Code," and the copies thereof shall be submitted by the Organization's representative (Academic Secretary or another official) to the **Committee**.
- 18.3. The **Contract** shall be signed after the arrival of the beneficiary **Principal Investigator** to the Republic of Armenia, upon the announcement of the results of the Call.
- 18.4. The **Projects** shall be implemented within the timeframes outlined in the **Contract**.

##### 19. Reporting

- 19.1. The **PI** of the **Group** shall submit Interim and Final **Reports** on Project Implementation.
- 19.2. The **PI** of the **Group** shall submit an Interim Implementation **Report** to the **Committee** every 12<sup>th</sup> month (by the last working day) since the commencement of the **Project**. Based on the reports, the **Board** shall decide on the continuation of funding of the **Project**.
- 19.3. By the 35<sup>th</sup> month (by the last working day) since the commencement of the **Project**, the **PI** of the **Group** shall submit a triennial report to the **Committee**, which shall include the description of anticipated intermediate results of the **Project** (as outlined in Subparagraph 9.2). Based on those reports, the **Board** shall decide whether to terminate the **Project's** funding or continue it for another 24 months.

- 19.4. By the 60<sup>th</sup> month (by the last working day) since the commencement of the **Project**, the **PI** of the **Group** shall submit the Final report to the **Committee** with the indication of the expected results outlined in **Subparagraphs 9.4, 9.5., and 9.6.**, as a result of which the **Board** shall issue a conclusion on the acceptance of the report.
- 19.5. With the aim of assessing the quality and effectiveness of the research system, the **Committee** is entitled to initiate interim monitoring of the **Project** and present the results to the **Board**.
- 19.6. While deciding on the continuation of funding of the **Project**, the **Board** shall take into consideration the results of the monitoring carried out by the **Committee**.
- 19.7. The **Committee** reserves the right to publish the abstracts and reports of the funded **Projects** either in a paper-based or electronic format.

## 20. Additional Information

- 20.1. Should the submitted **Project** and the reports based thereon include intellectual property or patent rights objects, the **PI** shall comply with the Laws of the Republic of Armenia “On Copyright and Related Rights” and “On Inventions, Utility Models and Industrial Designs.”
- 20.2. The **PI** shall be allowed to apply to the **Committee** in order to redistribute the financial means envisaged in the “Other Costs” section of the **Estimate of the Contract** by submitting an appropriate justification and receiving the **Committee’s** written permission thereto. If redistribution is made, an agreement forming an integral part of the Contract (hereinafter referred to as the Agreement) shall be concluded to enshrine the change in the Contract, and an amended version of the Contract estimate shall be submitted to the **Committee**.
- 20.3. In the case of the **PI’s** incapability to continue performing their duties, upon the suggestion of the **Head** of the **Organization** and the consent of the scientific board of the **Organization** and the **Group Members**, as well as with the written approval of the **Committee**, it is possible to replace the **PI**. In the case of the **PI’s** replacement, an Agreement shall be concluded with the new **PI** of the **Group**, in which they undertake to carry out the **Project** pursuant to the **Contract**.
- 20.4. The **PI** of the **Group** may apply to the **Committee** with a request to make an equivalent change to the **Collaborator** or a **Group Member**, providing an appropriate justification. In the case of a change in the list of **Group Members**, an Agreement shall be concluded to enshrine the change in the Contract, and a copy of the contract signed with the new member under the grant project shall be submitted to the **Committee**.
- 20.5. The **PI** may apply to the **Committee** with a request to reduce the number of **Group Members** by one, providing an appropriate justification. In the case of a reduction in the number of **Group Members**, an Agreement shall be concluded to enshrine the change in the Contract.



- 20.6. During the implementation of the **Project** (no earlier than 12 months after the commencement), the **PI** is entitled to apply to the **Committee** with a proposal to increase the number of the **Group Members** by a maximum of 2 performers under the age of 35 holding a qualification relevant to the **Project**, along with an appropriate justification.
- 20.7. The **Group Members** involved in the **Project** under Subparagraph 20.6 shall not be employed in any Organization carrying out a program within the framework of basic funding for scientific and technical activities from the state budget of the Republic of Armenia.
- 20.8. In the case of an increase in the number of **Group Members**, the value of the **Contract** shall increase by AMD 1,800,000 gross per each new **Group Member** (for the period of 12 months). In that case, an Agreement shall be concluded to enshrine the change in the Contract, and a copy of the contract signed with the new member under the grant project shall be submitted to the **Committee**.
- 20.9. The absence of any **Group Member** from the Republic of Armenia for 2 or more consecutive months during 12 months must be agreed upon in writing with the **Committee** in advance.

## 21. Termination of the Project Funding

The **Committee** is entitled to terminate the funding of the **Project** in the following cases:

- Interim implementation reports have not been submitted within the established timeframe,
- the **Board** has issued a negative conclusion on the feasibility of further funding of the Project;
- A redistribution of financial means has been made in the “Other Costs” section of the **Estimate** without the **Committee’s** written permission thereto;
- A change has been made in the list of the **Group Members** without the **Committee’s** written permission thereto,
- The absence of any **Group Member** from the Republic of Armenia for a consecutive period of two or more months during 12 months without the **Committee’s** written permission thereto,
- The provisions of Subparagraphs 8.5, 8.6 and 9.2. of the present **Call** failed to be fulfilled. Moreover, such noncompliance shall also affect further **Applications** from the **Organization** in the amount determined in the conclusion of the **Board** formed for the next **Calls for Proposals**.
